## APPLICATION FOR DEFERRED ADJUDICATION

To the Honorable JUDGE PAT MCCROY of said Court:

Now comes, \_\_\_\_\_, defendant in the above styled and numbered cause and enters His plea of Nolo Cont; request a deferred adjudication of the offense which he/she is charged and would show the court;

The defendant alleges that, if the court accepts His plea of Nolo Cont, the court will defer final adjudication of this cause of action for 90 days during which time the defendant will not violate the traffic laws of this or any other state. Further, defendant shall pay with this application the full amount of the citation and shall post a NON-REFUNDABLE cash bond in the amount of \$50.00.

The defendant does state that He is not under a deferred order of any court nor has not made application for a deferred adjudication to any other court at this time; holds only a valid Texas driver's license, and said license are not revoked, suspended or under probation at this time.

At the conclusion of the deferral period, the defendant SHALL PRESENT satisfactory evidence that he/she has complied with the above conditions, then the court shall dismiss the complaint; may impose a special expense not to exceed the amount of the bond; the bond shall be reduced to pay said special expense and there will be no final conviction; and the complaint may not be used against the defendant for any purpose. In the event satisfactory proof IS NOT shown the court of compliance, or the defendant does not comply as set forth; the court may proceed with an adjudication of guilt, reduce the bond posted to a fine and enter a guilty plea on the original charge.
